NEW: All new applications must be accompanied by two checks - one check payable to NSSAR in the amount of \$52.00, and one check payable to MOSSAR in the amount of \$12.00. National and State dues shall **NOT** be prorated. All new applications received after January 1st shall have dues and fees credited to that calendar year.

Each Chapter is to determine the amount of Chapter dues. The Chapter Treasurer shall be responsible for collecting all dues and is to forward the National Society and State Society dues to the MOSSAR Treasurer in a timely manner. The Chapter check **must** be made payable to the MOSSAR Treasurer.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP IN NSSAR AND MOSSAR: A Life Membership is available in the National Society and in the Missouri Society. You **must** be a Life Member in the National Society before you can become a Life Member in the Missouri Society. Contact the President for copies of rate forms. MOSSAR rates are dependant upon your age at the time of purchase. NSSAR National Life Membership is \$500.00 regardless of age.

REINSTATEMENT: All membership, except Life Members, expire December 31st of each year. Any member failing to pay all dues and fees in full before March 15th of the following year shall be dropped from membership for nonpayment of dues and shall be required to execute an Application for Reinstatement of Membership and pay ALL current year's dues in full plus a \$3.00 reinstatement fee prior to his reinstatement as a member in good standing.

TRANSFERS TO MOSSAR FROM ANOTHER SOCIETY: A fee in the amount of \$3.00 must be collected from a member transferring into MOSSAR from another State Society. This fee is required to cover costs of obtaining a copy of the member's original, approved application papers. If the member provides a copy of his original, approved application papers at the time of transfer, the \$3.00 fee is waived.
