## NEWSLETTER

Compatriot Stuart E. Elliott, our new Executive Secretary, has a new larger computer and is in the process of transferring over all SAR data, which will allow us to get our information faster in the future. Membership Cards are enclosed with this Newsletter and will be mailed each year with the Newsletter following the April Board of Directors meeting.

Several members have inquired how our cards are issued and when and why? Our dues year ends each December 31st and all memberships are to be renewed by that time. Each November our Executive Secretary will mail out dues statements to all annual members, the member should return his check to the address on the statement before December 31st, if he fails to do so, ONE (1) late notice will be mailed in January and his name sent to his Chapter for them to make a personal contact. Due to the cost of postage and labor today, anyone that has not paid will be dropped from membership and will have to pay a reinstatement charge in addition to his dues to process the Reinstatement Application that is required. Each April 1st the National Association and the individual Chapters are issued checks for their Per Capita dues as collected by the state, at the same time that the computer issues these checks, it will also issue the membership cards of the current paid members.

The above figures show that each and everyone of us needs to get out and sign up at least one (1) more member this year. The most important thing to the Society that any member can do is to bring in a new member.

The members of each Chapter should encourage the President of your Chapter to attend all Board of Directors meetings. Our By-Laws make the President of your Chapter a member of the Board of Directors and the representative of your Chapter at all meetings. We need and want all of the help and ideas that each of our members have and those are supposed to be brought to our Board meetings by your Chapter President.

At the April 18, 1984 Board of Directors meeting held in Sedalia, three (3) new Chapters were approved, they are:

Braxton C. Pollard Chapter, Paris, MO.; John Righter Chapter, Poplar Bluff, MO.; and the John Davis Chapter, St. Joseph, MO.

All chapters were named after Revolutionary War soldiers. The dates for presentation of the Charters by President Wollard are: 16 June 1984 for Righter Chapter & 30 June 1984 for the Pollard Chapter. All members are invited.

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As approved by the Board of Directors at the January 28, 1984 meeting, all of the old records and papers of the Missouri have been donated to the State Historical Society of Missouri in Columbia. They will be stored in the Western Historical Manuscripts Collection and are available to S.A.R. members and the public for research and copying should anyone ever desire to do so. Some of the records date back to the 1890's and are now safe from loss and unexpected problems that might occur moving them from one Secretary to the next. Our thanks to Compatriot Francis L. Stubbs, President of the M. Graham Clark Chapter in Columbia for making all of the arrangements.

At the April 28, 1984, Board of Directors meeting the Board voted to appoint Compatriot Stuart E. Elliott as Executive Secretary under Article Nine of our By-Laws, giving him the title for the job that he and his computer have already been doing for us for the last two years. They also approved the budget for the 1984-1985 year, a copy of which is enclosed with this newsletter.

Compatriot William Harrison Nims, Jr., who has been our Awards Chairman for several years, asked not to be reappointed this year and we want to take this opportunity to publicly thank him for the fine job and many hours he devoted to making our state wide R.O.T.C. medals and awards program the success that it is today. President Wollard has appointed Colonel James A. Shelby, Lexington, Missouri to be our Awards Chairman this year.

Compatriot Schulze has agreed to serve again this year as our State Eagle Scout Chairman, every Chapter should contact him for information on this very important program and the scholarship that is offered. ## NEWSLETTER

Your Missouri Society has grown in the last six months with the chartering of four new Chapters: the Braxton C. Pollard Chapter, Paris; the John Righter Chapter, Poplar Bluff; the John Davis Chapter, St. Joseph and the Harry S. Truman Chapter, Independence.

At the July meeting of your Board of Directors, approval was also given for three more Chapters: the Alexander Majors Chapter in South Kansas City and Chapters in Maryville and Warrensburg, yet to be named for Revolutionary War Compatriots buried in their vicinity.

At the National Congress this summer, the elected Delegates voted to raise the National Society new application fee to \$35.00, to be submitted with each application. They also voted to raise the annual dues to \$10.00 per capita, which will be reflected on your 1985 dues statement that we will be sending out this November. Any member who will be out of town or on vacation in December and January, please make arrangements to see that your dues are paid by December 31st. Any member who is dropped for non payment and then wishes to be reinstated, will have to pay a \$10.00 Reinstatement fee, in addition to all dues owed in order to be reinstated after January 1st 1985. ALL MEMBERSHIPS EXPIRE EACH DECEMBER 31st!

With this Newsletter, you will find a copy of the new Dues & Fees schedule for the Missouri Society. President Wollard has notified MOSAR Registrar Bill Wood that any application that he receives from now on without the proper fees in two checks, ie: \$35.00 to the National Society, S.A.R. and \$19.00 to the Missouri Society, S.A.R., are to be returned to the sponsor of the applicant for the proper checks. There will be no exceptions to this rule, since we are growing at such a rate that it is impossible to make our accounting and record keeping systems work without the full cooperation of each Chapter and every member.

State Treasurer Duncan Kincheloe and Executive Secretary Stuart Elliott have worked for months developing a total computer accounting program for our Society, with a general ledger, check & deposit register and budget varification, which will give us a full quarterly financial statement and an annual financial statement, instead of the old and limited balance sheets that we worked on for years. Each Chapter President will receive a copy of the third quarter financial statement when we meet for our regular Board of Directors meeting the fourth Saturday in October at Sedalia. These financial statements will be available to all members from your Chapter President after the Board meeting.

Due to all of the requests that we have had from members who object to driving all of the way across the state for meetings, the Board has decided to hold the Annual Membership Meeting at Columbia, in the center of the state, on the last Saturday in March 1985. We have also had a number of requests from members and especially from their wives, that we go back to the format where we hold the business meeting from 1pm to 3pm on Saturday afternoon and then have a really nice social dinner in the evening, where everyone can dress up and have a really relaxed nice time. Motel reservations will be arranged for Saturday night and you will be notified of the discount rates prior to the meeting.

We need for each and every member to get out and sign up at least one new member every year, so that we can continue to grow. The most important thing that any Compatriot can do for his Society is to bring in a new member. Application papers and worksheets are available

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on request from your Chapter President or Chapter Register, who will be glad to help you with any questions you may have about the application forms. Also President Wollard is always glad to answer any questions and aid in bringing in new members if you need help in the matter, and don't find the answers elsewhere. His phone is: [816] 776-8953. All memberships expire each December 31st and there is now a ten dollar (\$10.00) Reinstatement Fee required if we are forced to drop a member for non-payment, in addition to all back dues and fees. We have had to resort to this because the high cost of re-billing and remailing dues statement to those who pay late have become a substantial cost to your Society which we cannot afford and good business practices, as you want your Board of Directors to follow, make us follow this procedure.

The Harry S. Truman Chapter, Independence, Missouri and the Alexander Majors Chapter in Kansas City have been Chartered and President Wollard is working on several other Chapters which should be Chartered in the next few months. The most important need of our Society and the program that we all as members must work toward is the growth of our fine Society by signing up new members.
