Charles Leon Land at 96 years of age passed away at the Missouri Veterans Home in St. Louis County, Missouri on January 16, 2025.

His talents in life were refinishing floors and making others laugh. Leon was the son of Albert Clifton (AC) Land and Gertude "Josie" Land born on February 23. 1928.

He graduated from Ferguson High School in 1946 and then served in the United States Army at the end of World War II from 1946 to 1948.
