There are three data files: MOSSAR¹ Patriots, MOSSAR Members and Missouri Patriot Graves.

MOSSAR Patriots is an alphabetical listing by Patriot Surname with associated member names and NSSAR² Membership Number.

MOSSAR Members is an alphabetical listing by Member Surname with associated NSSAR Membership Number and Patriots.

MOSSAR Patriots and MOSSAR Members data may assist you in identification of your Patriots and members of your family that joined MOSSAR. A copy of the genealogy from member to Patriot may be ordered from NSSAR. The document is called a Record Copy and will contain the "best information" available when submitted. Some of the earlier applications may require additional research to validate dates, places and names. The assistance of a current MOSSAR member may be helpful to you. Please check the Chapters page of this web site to locate a Chapter near your residence and contact it for assistance.

Missouri Patriots Graves listing is a collection of information about the known 600+ Patriots buried in Missouri. This listing may assist to identify counties for additional research. The list of Revolutionary War soldiers buried in Missouri was compiled by Ms. Betty Harvey Williams and published in the <u>Journal of the Missouri State Genealogical Association, Vol. 5 No. 3 & 4.</u> Ms. Williams has explained that this list "is in no way complete and the accuracy of this list is somewhat in doubt." The list is published with the consent of Ms. Williams and the Missouri State Genealogical Association.
