

## NATIONAL CONGRESS REPORT

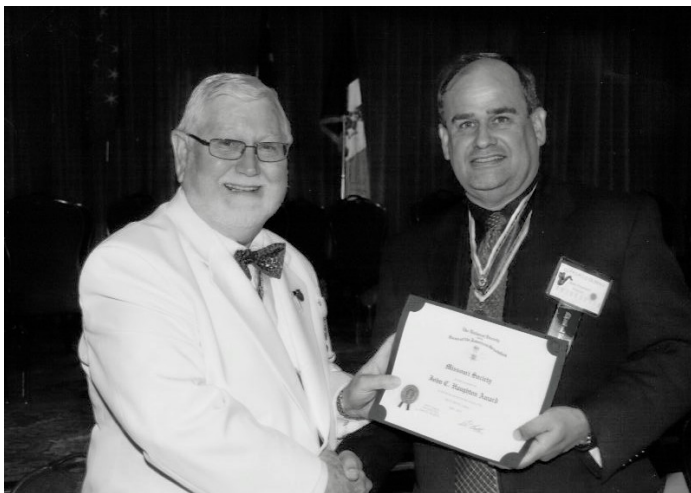
On June 26 to July 1, the 120th Annual NSSAR Congress was held in Cleveland OH. Missouri was well represented with ten members and eight guests in attendance.
